### Awards Criteria

**Blue Ribbon Club** -Completion of 1 USPC Dressage Rally at the Walk/Trot Level or above and 1 USDF or USEF Dressage Show at the Walk/Trot Level.

**Medallion Club** -Completion of 1 USPC Dressage Rally at the Training Level or above and 1 USDF or USEF Dressage Show at the Training Level.

**Bronze Medal Club** -Completion of 1 USPC Dressage Rally at the First Level and 1 USDF or USEF Dressage Show at the First Level.

**Silver Medal Club** -Completion of one USPC Dressage Rally at the Second Level and 1 USDF or USEF Dressage Show at the Second Level.

**Gold Medal Club** -Completion of one USPC Dressage Rally (this can be in competition at any level or by being a volunteer for the rally) and completion of 1 USDF or USEF Dressage Show at Third level or above.

All competitions must be done during the current year. Interested Pony Clubbers should get their applications from their DCs or download them from the Forms page of the USPC website [www.ponyclub.org](http://www.ponyclub.org). It will be the responsibility of the Pony Club member to get all the information together and send it to the National Office by the November 15<sup>th</sup> deadline each year. Riders may apply for more than one award each year.
