

Dressage C Level Unmounted Lesson

TITLE: *THE STOCK TIE*

OBJECTIVES

Long Term Goal: To know how to tie a stock tie.

Short Term Goal: To get a basic idea of how to tie a stock tie and its history.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

2 Stock Ties & Two 2 Liter Pop Bottles.

What (Phases)	How (Exercises, system, games)	Why (Goal Setting)	Time (Estimates)
<i>Intro/ Welcome</i>	<i>Game or Method:</i> Introduce yourself. Ask the names of students and if they have ever tied a stock tie.	<i>Teacher's goal:</i> To know the names of the students and to find out how much experience they have.	(Est. 2 min)
<i>Warm-up</i>	<i>Game or Method:</i> Ask the kids if they know where a stock tie is used and what it was originally used for. You may mention that Fox Hunting was where it was originally used.	<i>Mental/Physical Prep:</i> Get them thinking about what the stock could have been used for and where they have seen it.	(Est. 2 min)
<i>Feedback</i>	<i>Question/Sharing:</i> Review and discuss the answers.	<i>Teacher's Assessment:</i> See how well they knew about the stock tie.	(Est. 1 min)
<i>Transition</i>	<i>Practice or one time around to get idea of lesson/game, relax:</i> Show the members the tie, Explain that they will be practicing on the bottles. The bottles are the neck.	<i>Cement for lesson:</i> Practicing tying a stock tie.	(Est. 4 min)
<i>Lesson</i>	<i>Game/Method to teach Goal:</i> Have the kids tie a stock tie and judge each others. Talk about what was right or wrong about it.	<i>Achieve Goal:</i> Did the kid(s) tie a satisfactory stock tie? If not help the kid(s) fix it.	(Est. 3 min)
<i>Conclusion/ Feedback</i>	<i>Slow paced game/activity while teacher & students ask/answer questions:</i> Have the kids race to tie the neatest stock tie in the least amount of time.	<i>Check for understanding and/ feedback for next lesson:</i> Ask what they learned and make sure that they understood the importance of the stock.	(Est. 3 min)
